

Epinephrine doses for GI bleeding and pre-polypectomy

1. GI bleeding or pedunculated polyp pre-treatment

Injection of epinephrine in a dilution with saline solution of 1:10,000 (1 ml of epinephrine in 9 ml of saline)

2. There are also recommendations from experts about injection of diluted epinephrine at a concentration of 1:100,000 (**.1 ml of epinephrine in 9 ml of saline**) into large flat/sessile polyps to prevent intra-procedural bleeding.
